Dear Wisconsin Children's Safety Advocates:

In November 2007, the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission issued a total of **thirty-six (36) recalls relating to products affecting children**. Attached is a summary of the releases identifying the product, problem and what should be done with the recalled product.

We have found that not all of the recalls are picked up by the news media as they occur. This monthly summary will give you the opportunity to review all of the children's product safety recalls for the past month.

**Release Number (08-058):** Tween Brands Inc., of New Albany, Ohio, is voluntarily recalling about 4,000 Decorative Packaging Pearl-like Bead Attachments sold with Girl's Gift Sets. The recalled item is a pearl-like pink bead attachment on the outside packaging of the gift sets and a zipper pull/wrist band on a cosmetic lip gloss set. The gift sets were sold under the "Sparkle by Too" line, as follows: 3-Pack Lip Gloss Wristlet (Style No. 2014), 4-Pack Body Spray (Style No. 2017), and 3-Piece Bath Set (Style No. 2018). The items were sold at Limited Too retail stores nationwide, catalog and Web site from April 2007 through September 2007 for between \$11 and \$13 and manufactured in China.

**Problem:** Surface coating on a plastic bead decorative packaging attachment contains excessive levels of lead, violating the federal lead paint standard.

**What to do:** Consumers should immediately remove this recalled decorative pearl-like bead attachment from the gift sets and return it to any Limited Too store for a \$5 Limited Too coupon. In addition to the \$5 coupon, consumers who choose to return the gift sets along with the packaging attachment will receive a full refund. **Release Number (08-063):** Fisher-Price Inc., of East Aurora, N.Y., is voluntarily recalling about 155,000 Laugh & Learn™ Learning Kitchen™ Toys. The recall involves a play kitchen learning toy with a pretend refrigerator, range and sink. The product's item number L5067 is stamped in several locations on the toy

and printed on the product's packaging above the UPC. The items were sold at various retail and toy specialty stores nationwide from May 2007 through October 2007 for about \$70. The items were manufactured in Mexico.

**Problem:** Pieces of the faucet or the clock hands can detach, posing a choking hazard to young children.

**What to do:** Consumers should immediately take the recalled toys away from children and contact Fisher-Price for a free repair kit. **Release Number (08-065):** Swimways Corp., of Virginia Beach, Va., is voluntarily recalling about 31,000 "Skippy" Pool Toys. This recall involves a rubber pool toy shaped like a fish. The fish are blue, purple or green colored and measure 8 ½ inches long by 5 inches wide. A loop of elastic tubing shaped like a tongue comes out of the mouth of the fish and is used for launching the fish across the water like a slingshot. "WARNING. Do not aim at another person. Made in China" is printed on the bottom of the fish. It was sold at mass merchandisers and independent pool supply stores nationwide from February 2007 through September 2007 for about \$10.

**Problem:** The elastic tongue of the fish can break and forcefully come out and cut the users' hands during launching of the toy.

**What to do:** Consumers should take the toy away from children immediately and contact Swimways for a free replacement toy. For

**Release Number (08-067):** International Sourcing Ltd (ISL), of Springfield, Mo., is voluntarily recalling about 7,500 Dragster and Funny Car toys. The recall includes plastic models of a dragster and funny car. The dragster is approximately 22 inches long, black in color with various sponsor decals on the toys. The funny car is approximately 14 inches long

and is also black in color. Both models have the ISL logo imprinted on the underside. **Problem:** Surface paint on the wheels and engine of the toys contains excessive levels of lead, violating the federal lead paint standard.

**Release Number (08-070):** Schylling Associates Inc., of Rowley, Mass., is voluntarily recalling about 3,600 Winnie-the-Pooh Spinning Top. In August 2007, 66,000 spinning tops were

recalled. The recalled spinning top is primarily metal and has wooden handles. The top is printed with Winnie-the-Pooh characters. Tops with plastic handles are not included in this recall. The toys were sold at specialty toy stores and gift shops nationwide from April 2003 through November 2003 for about \$12 and manufactured in China.

**Problem:** Surface paint on the wooden handle of the top contains excessive levels of lead, violating the federal lead paint standard.

**Problem:** Surface paints on the robot contain excessive levels of lead, which violates the federal lead paint standard.

**Release Number (08-074):** Spin Master, of Toronto, Canada, is voluntarily recalling about 4.2 million Aqua Dots. The recalled toy is a craft kit which allows children to create various multi-dimensional designs using small colored beads. The beads fuse together when sprayed with water. The recall applies to all models of Aqua Dots. The product is available in various different kits with accessories such as a drying

fan, applicator pen, design templates for the beads, and spray bottle. The product is labeled for ages 4+. The toys were sold at mass merchandisers nationwide from April 2007 through November 2007 for between \$17 and \$30 and manufactured in China.

**Problem:** The coating on the beads that causes the beads to stick to each other when water is added contains a chemical that can turn toxic when many are ingested. Children who swallow the beads can become comatose, develop respiratory depression, or have seizures.

**What to do:** Consumers should immediately take the recalled toy away from children and contact Spin Master to return for free replacement beads or a toy of equal value. **Release Number (08-075):** Bassettbaby, of Bassett, Va., is voluntarily recalling about 8,900 Wendy Bellissimo Collection Convertible Cribs. This recall involves Wendy Bellissimo Collection convertible cribs, model numbers 5945-0521 and 5545-0521, sold in honey and cherry finishes. The full size cribs have a sleigh design and one of the following purchase order numbers at the bottom rail of the headboard: 272903, 272904, 273904, 276728, 276729, 291081, 323975, 324472, 320318, 323976, 332883 365620, 368466 in honey, and 338535, 338537 and 332884 in cherry. **Release Number (08-078):** Yamaha Corporation of America, of Buena Park, Calif., is voluntarily recalling about 49,000 Yamaha AC Power Adaptors. This recall involves the Yamaha PA-3C power adaptor with a date code of 0624. The adaptor is used with Yamaha keyboards and digital drum sets. The model number is written in white print on the front of the plug of the adaptor and the date code is etched into the plastic at the bottom of the plug panel. **Release Number (08-080):** Dolgencorp Inc., of Goodlettsville, Tenn., is voluntarily recalling about 51,000 Children's Fashion Sunglasses. The recall involves yellow children's sunglasses. No other colors of sunglasses are included in this recall. The word "CHINA" is printed on the left side of the frame. **Release Number (08-107):** American Greetings Corp., of Cleveland, Ohio, is voluntarily recalling about 60,000 DesignWare® Confetti Bursts. The recalled products contain confetti in plastic bags. When the bags are inflated, consumers squeeze the bag and confetti bursts out. Each package contains six confetti bursts. The items were sold at discount, toy, drug, grocery, party, and specialty/gift stores nationwide from December 2003 through

September 2007 for about \$3 and manufactured in China.

**Problem:** The surface paint on the individual bags of confetti contains excessive levels of lead, violating the federal lead paint standard.

**What to do:** Consumers should immediately take the recalled confetti bursts away from children and contact American Greetings for instructions on returning the confetti bursts to American Greetings to receive a coupon redeemable wherever American Greetings' products are sold.
