

Jalisco will bolster agricultural ties to Wisconsin

Due to affinities shared with the agricultural sector of Wisconsin, Jalisco will strength collaborations with this U.S. state with which Jalisco has had close ties for the past 15 years, said the head of the Department of Rural Development for the State of Jalisco, Secretary Hector Padilla Gutiérrez.

The Secretary noted that among the topics discussed between Jalisco and Wisconsin is the strength of their dairy sectors which are backed up by active organizations, such as cooperatives of dairy producers.

Cooperatives in the region of Los Altos have benefited from transfer of technology and economic exchange with the productive sector and authorities in Wisconsin. The Secretary participated in a meeting with dairy cooperatives from Jalisco and the Wisconsin delegation, led by the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection, Ben Brancel.

The meeting in Tepatitlán will take place during the opening of the International Dairy Cattle Conference (CIGAL 2016), to be held June 15th-17th in the city of Guadalajara.
